



Payment Policy in Regards to Quarantine/COVID-19

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Effective April 5th, 2021 the payment policy pertaining to quarantine/COVID-19 related absences will change.

The new policy now states, a child will have up to 2 weeks of your contracted hours for quarantine/COVID related absences without pay per calendar year. All days beyond the 2 weeks of your contracted hours in a calendar year will be billed at the regular childcare rate.

How to use quarantine/COVID days: If a child will be absent due to quarantine/COVID, please inform the Kinder-Haus office in written form the date of exposure/onset of symptoms, timeframe of quarantine, and number of days the child will miss. Kinder-Haus will keep an annual record of days used for quarantine/COVID related absences.

If Kinder-Haus must close due to multiple COVID cases in the building, days missed due to closing will not count against the quarantine/COVID absences for a child. In addition, if a child must quarantine due to COVID exposure at Kinder-Haus, those absences will not pertain to this new policy.
