



Rifle Range Guidelines

Please communicate these guidelines with all participants

Our newly renovated shooting range provides a safe and fun experience for adults and youth. Take aim at steel and paper targets from our 12'x40' shooting pavilion at distances up to 30 yards. Our NRA certified Range Safety Officers will provide guidance during your visit.

Fees & Scheduling

- Range use must be prescheduled with the camp office (one month prior to use).
- An hourly rate is charged to use the range.
- Ammo is an additional charge when using camp provided rifles.

General Safety

- A camp approved Range Safety Officer must be present whenever the range is in use.
- Always listen to and obey the Range Safety Officer. Unsafe behavior will not be tolerated.
- No one is permitted in the field above the ranges when the range is in use.
- Youth must be over the age of 10 to shoot without parental supervision.
- Maintain a ratio of one adult to every five youth- close supervision is a must!
- Teach respect for these firearms - Safety First!

Using Personal Equipment

- Use of the following personal equipment is permitted
 - Hand Guns—Any caliber
 - Rifles—22, 223, 556 caliber
 - Soda cans & two liter bottles (allow additional time for clean up)
- Appropriate Target Use
 - White targets: 22 caliber and handgun calibers. Except 44 magnum.
 - Red targets: Rifle calibers 22 magnum, 223 and 556 only. Handgun calibers 44 magnum & higher.
 - High powered rifles must be shot on paper.

Camp Provided Program

- Camp will provide 22 caliber rifles.
- Typically, a group of 12-15 kids can shoot 30 rounds per person in one hour.
